If irritation develops, get medical attention.
Skin contact: Wash with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing.

Respiratory Protection: Not usually needed in ventilated area. If necessary, wear an OSHA approved respirator.
Protective Clothing: Nitrile gloves and chemical splash goggles.
Additional Measures: Do not place product in unmarked container. Keep away from children. Slippery when spilled.
